- Search for your book online by title, author or subject;
- Renew your books online.
- Request to be notified by email when the book is available.
- Download your book to your PC, Mac, iPad, iPhone, Android or Kindle.
- Get the Hawaii Mobile app by searching “chilifresh Hawaii” in the Google Play or Apple app store.

Class Descriptions

- ✓ **Library Downloads:** (2 hours) Please bring your mobile device to class along with your library card. **Lucy Maloney** will show you how to search and download an e-book to your iPad, iPhone or Kindle. Limit 4. (\$20)
- ✓ **Excel:** (6 hours) Number crunching. **Lucy Maloney** teaches the spreadsheet program **Excel 2010**. You will learn how to use your computer like a calculator by creating formulas which tell it add, subtract, multiply, divide ---in a nanosecond! You will also learn how to create pie charts and bar charts from a table of figures you create. Limit 4 (\$42)
- ✓ **iPad 1 & 2:** (6 hours each) iPads are hot! More than 22 million have sold since April 2010 and there are now more than 300,000 apps that will run on the device. In iPad 1 **Glenn Grace** will show you how to get the most out of that new iPad you got for Christmas whether it's a version 1,2,3, Air, Air2, a mini or even an iPad Pro! Please bring your iPad to class along with your Apple ID and password. Minimum of 3 students required. (\$60 includes workbook) In iPad 2 **Terri Powell** will show you how to have even more fun with your iPad, more photos, more music, more apps. (\$42 each)
- ✓ **iPhone 1 & 2** (6 hours each) **Greg Navarro** and **Terri Powell** take turns teaching iPhone 1. In this exciting class they show you the many ways you can use your iPhone in addition to calling someone. You can text, Skype, email, get driving directions using the GPS app, take pictures, listen to music, download and read books, etc. etc. In iPhone 2 **Terri** will show you how to change your ring tones to identify the caller, how to use your iPhone as a camera, a flashlight and a timer as well as lots of great free apps to download. It doesn't matter which version of iPhone you have, you will be sure to learn something new! Please bring your iPhone to class along with your Apple ID and password. (\$42 each).

Our Core Classes

- ✓ **Computer Fundamentals 1:** (6 hours) **Aileen Lum** teaches Windows 10 computer basics: turning it off and on, saving your work and finding it again. Basic mouse skills. (\$60 includes workbook)
- ✓ **Computer Fundamentals 2:** (6 hours) **Greg Navarro** shows more advanced students how to create folders on your desktop, how to personalize your computer, how to burn CDs and DVDs, how to save to a flash drive. (\$42)
- ✓ **Word Processing:** (6 hours) This is not a typing class! **Susan Labrenz** will show you how to move your words around on a digital sheet of paper, insert a picture and print a catchy invitation or poster. (\$60 includes workbook)
- ✓ **Internet & Email:** (6 hours) **Greg Navarro** covers the basics of how to stay safe while surfing the internet and how to email, forward and copy each other. (\$42)
